Making a Will is the only way you can be sure that your wishes are carried out and your loved ones are provided for after your death.

- You marry, divorce or cohabit
- Your financial situation alters
- You buy a new pet

## Why should I make my Will in St Luke's Will Month?

Quite simply, you'll be getting great value for money, at the same time as supporting our patients and their families. Will Month is a partnership between St Luke's and local solicitors across the city. A participating solicitor will draw up a basic Will\* for you, and invite you to make a donation in place of their fee. This will help local people who have a terminal illness, at a time when every day matters more than ever.

You may also choose to leave a gift to St Luke's in your Will if you wish. Ask your solicitor for more details.

## How do I take part?

Will Month takes place in April 2026, so bookings are being taken now – be sure to book yours in early to avoid disappointment! Appointments may be held in person, by phone or video call depending on your personal circumstances and/or wishes.

2 Have your Will written by the solicitor of your choice.

3 Make your donation to St Luke's online prior to your appointment or via your solicitor.

St Luke's is an independent charity caring for terminally ill adults and their loved ones across Sheffield. Our care is provided at no cost to our patients and we rely on our generous supporters to keep our work going.

Each year, we care for nearly **1,800** patients - most of whom are cared for in their own home by our Specialist Palliative Care Community team.

It's not just patients that we help either - we extend support, bereavement counselling and practical help to family members and carers too, so that each year, our work touches the lives of more than **6,000** people.

We are not part of the NHS and of the **£15million** it takes to deliver our services each year, **£11million** of that comes from donations - just like yours.
